## Safety Rules

- DO NOT inflate in high wind, rain, or thunderstorms.
- Unload all occupants and deflate inflatable if winds become excessive.
- Use an adequate 3-wire extension cord ex: (10 gauge for 100ft and 12 gauge for a 50.)
- Always connect the blower to the extension cord before plugging into power source.
- Always use stakes
- Limit occupants to the number specified for the unit size.
- Always ensure there is adequate clearance around and above the ride 3' perimeter, especially overhead power lines.
- If power should go off during the time children or adults are playing, the bouncer will deflate rapidly. Ask all occupants to immediately sit down then the responsible adults will evacuate each person individually.
- Do not wear shoes
- Remove glasses and/or other sharp objects
- No rough housing
- No silly string
- No summersaults or flips
- Do not enter bouncer with sharp objects

## Site Layout

- Pick a location free from overhead power or telephone lines. Locations should be free from trees that could damage or stain the inflatable. An unobstructed area should be maintained for 5ft around the perimeter of the inflatable.
- Ensure there are no underground irrigation pipes or other utilities that the property owner has installed.
- If putting a bouncer on any other surface other than grass, be sure to ask for the ground mat.
- Keep the inflatable clear and accessible at all times.
- Have fun but be safe!
- Adult supervision is required at all times. NEVER leave children unattended.
